PRESS STATEMENT

Today **10** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **1,008** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.0%**. From the cases, **9** are Kenyans while **1** are foreigners. **6** are males while **4** are females. The youngest is a **22-year-old** infant while the oldest is **60** years old. Total confirmed

positive cases are now **337,884** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **3,834,678**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **5**, Siaya 3, Kajiado and Uasin Gishu **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(4)**, 30-39 **(2)**, 40-49 **(1)** 50-59 **(2)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Today, **49** patients have recovered from the disease, **48** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **1** is from a facility countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **331,929** of whom **278,352** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,577** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Fortunately, no patient has succumbed to the disease therefore the cumulative fatalities remain **5,672**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**151**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years (**1,031**), 60 years and above (**3,321**).

There are **43** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **240** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **8** patients are on supplemental oxygen, **1** in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) while **7** are in General Wards.

VACCINATION:

As of August 8th 2022, a total of **20,875,392** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,610,320** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). Another **1,881,341** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **322,467** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,061,264** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **6,020** while the total number of people fully vaccinated in the last 24 hours is **2,125**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **34.3%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.
