## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **MEASURES, AS AT AUGUST 20,** **2022**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today, **20** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,462** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.4%**. **17** of the cases are Kenyans while **3** are foreigners. **11** are female while **9** are male. The youngest is aged **16** years while the oldest is **97** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,042**

with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,844,875**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **10** cases are from Kisii, **7** Nairobi and Kajiado recorded **3** cases.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**0**), 10-19 years (**1**), 20-29 years (**2**), 30-39 (**6**), 40-49 (**4**) 50-59 (**3**), 60 years and above (**4**).

Today, **10** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,221** of whom **278,629** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,592** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,673**.

Cumulative deaths by age are; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**151**), 30-39 years (**411**), 40-49 years (**652**), 50-59 years

**(1,032), 60 years and above (3,321).**

There are **26** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **113** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **6** patients are on supplemental oxygen, **1** in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) while **5** are in General Wards.

## **VACCINATION:**

As of August 19<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **20,956,062** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,648,248** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **1,891,723** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **333,059** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,083,032** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **8,255** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **2,764**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated

was **34.4%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
