PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **5** people have tested positive from a sample size of **768** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.7%**. **4** of the cases are Kenyans while **1** is a foreigner. **3** are male while **2** are female. The youngest is aged **16** years while the oldest is **41** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,047** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,845,643**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **3** cases are from Nairobi while Mandera and Nyeri have recorded **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(0)**, 30-39 **(3)**, 40-49 **(1)** 50-59 **(0)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Today, **18** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,239** of whom **278,647** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,592** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,673**.

Cumulative deaths by age are; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(411)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years

(1,032), 60 years and above **(3,321)**.

There are **26** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **109** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **6** patients are on supplemental oxygen, **1** in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) while **5** are in General Wards.

VACCINATION:

As of August 20th 2022, a total of **20,958,975** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,649,438** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **1,892,073** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **333,398** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,084,066** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **2,018** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **564**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated

was **34.4%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
