## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today, **4** people have tested positive from a sample size of **682** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.6%**. **All** the cases are Kenyans. **All** are male. The youngest is aged **30** years while the oldest is **50** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,165** with cumulative tests so far conducted

standing at **3,853,581**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **all** the **4** cases are from Nairobi.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(0)**, 30-39 **(1)**, 40-49 **(2)** 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Today, **13** patients have recovered from the disease, **8** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **5** are from various facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,350** of whom **278,749** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,601** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,674**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years

**(44)**, 20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(411)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **22** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **119** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** patient is in the ICU and is on ventilatory support.

## **VACCINATION:**

As of August 27<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **21,084,993** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,696,137** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **1,911,578** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **359,104** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,118,174** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **6,308** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **2,093**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated

was **34.5%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
