PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **5** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,062** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.5%**. **All** the cases are Kenyans. **3** are male while **2** are female. The youngest is aged **27** years while the oldest is **40** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,170** with cumulative tests

so far conducted standing at **3,854,643**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **3** cases are from Nairobi while Mombasa and Uasin Gishu **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(2)**, 30-39 **(1)**, 40-49 **(2)** 50-59 **(0)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Today, **20** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,370** of whom **278,769** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,601** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,674**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years

(44), 20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(411)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **23** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **103** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** patient is in the ICU and is on ventilatory support.

VACCINATION:

As of August 27th 2022, a total of **21,104,874** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,703,762** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **1,914,224** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **363,878** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,123,010** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **14,705** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **7,115**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated

was **34.5%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
