### **PRESS STATEMENT**

#### **VACCINATION:**

As of September 10<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **21,336,802** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,783,040** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

An additional **1,951,873** are doses administered to those between

15 to 17 years, **428,107** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,173,782** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **18,609** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **6,089**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **34.8%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.

Today, **5** people have tested positive from a sample size of **641** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.8%**. **2** of

the cases are Kenyans while **3** are Foreigners. **All** are female. The youngest is aged **30** years while the oldest is **60** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,295** with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,867,831**.

In terms of **County** distribution, all the **5** cases are from Nairobi.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(2)**, 30-39 **(0)**, 40-49 **(0)** 50-59 **(3)**, 60 years and above **(0)**.

Today, **13** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,521** of whom **278,905** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,616** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the

cumulative fatalities remain at **5,674**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(411)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **12** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **88** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.
