PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION:

As of September 14th 2022, a total of **21,437,009** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,817,245** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

An additional **1,967,773** are doses administered to those between

15 to 17 years, **453,266** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,198,725** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **26,686** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **9,005**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **34.9%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.

Today, **7** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,380** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.5%**. **5** of

the cases are Kenyans while **2** are foreigners. **4** are male while **3** are female. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,315** with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,871,142**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **4** cases are from Nairobi, Uasin Gishu **2** while Nakuru has **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**0**), 10-19 years (**1**), 20-29 years (**1**), 30-39 (**2**), 40-49 (**1**) 50-59 (**1**), 60 years and above (**1**).

Today, **2** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,548** of whom **278,932** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,616** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the

cumulative fatalities remain at **5,675**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(412)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **11** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **81** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.
