PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **9** people have tested positive from a sample size of **861** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.0%**. **5** of the cases are Kenyans while **4** are Foreigners. **8** are male while **1** is female. The youngest is aged **17** years while the oldest is **89** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,341** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,873,782**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **7** cases are from Nairobi, while Meru and Uasin Gishu have **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(0)**, 30-39 **(2)**, 40-49 **(2)** 50-59 **(2)**, 60 years and above **(2)**.

Today, **6** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,576** of whom **278,960** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,616** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,675**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years

(44), 20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(412)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **11** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **79** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

VACCINATION:

As of September 17th 2022, a total of **21,498,675** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,838,233** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

An additional **1,976,166** are doses administered to those between 15 to below 18 years, **472,933** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,211,343** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is

6,831 while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **2,939**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **34.9%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
