## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today, **8** people have tested positive from a sample size of **899** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.9%**. **5** of the cases are Kenyans while **3** are Foreigners. **7** are male while **1** is female. The youngest is aged **5** years while the oldest is **62** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,379** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,877,141**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **all** of the 8 cases are from Nairobi.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(2)**, 10-19 years **(1)**, 20-29 years **(1)**, 30-39 **(3)**, 40-49 **(0)** 50-59 **(0)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Today, **6** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,606** of whom **278,990** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,616** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,675**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(412)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59

years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **12** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **86** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

## **VACCINATION:**

As of September 20<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **21,540,711** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,857,475** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,459,598** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years, while **1,223,638** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **11,878** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **4,448**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **35.0%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a

targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
