PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **2** people have tested positive from a sample size of **707** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.3%**. **All** of the cases are Kenyans and are male. The youngest is aged **51** years while the oldest is **81** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,392** with cumulative tests so far conducted

standing at **3,879,861**.

In terms of **County** distribution, the **2** cases are from Nairobi.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(0)**, 10-19 years **(0)**, 20-29 years **(0)**, 30-39 **(0)**, 40-49 **(0)** 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(1)**.

Today, **9** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,629** of whom **279,013** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,616** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,675**.

Cumulative deaths by age are; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(412)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years

(1,032), 60 years and above (3,322).

There are **12** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **76** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.
