PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **16** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,112** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.4%**. **13** of the cases are Kenyans while **3** are Foreigners. **10** are male while **6** are female. The youngest is aged **4** years while the oldest is **49** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,420**

with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,881,967**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **12** cases are from Nairobi, Kilifi **3** and Kajiado **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**2**), 10-19 years (**0**), 20-29 years (**4**), 30-39 (**7**), 40-49 (**3**) 50-59 (**0**), 60 years and above (**0**).

Today, **34** patients have recovered from the disease, **33** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **1** is from a health facility in the country. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,663** of whom **279,046** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,617** are from various health facilities across the country.

Sadly, **3** patients have succumbed to the disease, and **all** are late deaths reported after conducting facility record audits in the months

of August and September 2022. This now pushes the cumulative fatalities to **5,678**.

Cumulative deaths by age are; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**152**), 30-39 years (**413**), 40-49 years (**653**), 50-59 years (**1,032**), 60 years and above (**3,322**).

There are **11** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **68** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

VACCINATION:

As of September 27th 2022, a total of **21,922,249** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,994,143** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,586,081** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,342,025** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **82,750** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **19,995**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **35.4%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
