PRESS STATEMENT

Today, **20** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,659** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.2%. 17** of the cases are Kenyans while **3** are foreigners. **11** are male while **9** are female. The youngest is aged **4** years while the oldest is **74** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,234**

with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at 3,859,601.

In terms of **County** distribution, **9** of the cases are from Kiambu, Nairobi **8**, Kajiado, Nakuru and Uasin Gishu **1** case each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (1), 10-19 years (3), 20-29 years (3), 30-39 (5), 40-49 (3) 50-59 (2), 60 years and above (3).

Today, **27** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,416** of whom **278,815** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,601** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,674**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (62), 10-19 years

(44), 20-29 (151), 30-39 years (411), 40-49 years (652), 50-59 years (1,032), 60 years and above (3,322).

There are **24** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **120** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** patient is in the ICU and is on ventilatory support. **2** other patients are on supplemental oxygen and are in the general ward.

VACCINATION:

As of September 2nd 2022, a total of **21,192,951** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,730,933** are dosesadministered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **1,929,581** are doses administered to those between 15 to 17 years, **392,404** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,140,033** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **17,308** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the

last 24 hours stand at 6,371. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated

was **34.6%.** The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
