PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION:

As of September 5th 2022, a total of **21,220,403** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,740,938** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

An additional **1,934,250** are doses administered to those between

15 to 17 years, **399,783** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,145,432** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **8,614** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **3,689**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **34.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.

Today, **6** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,393** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.4%**. **2** of the cases are Kenyans while **4** are Foreigners. **4** are female while **2** are male. The youngest is aged **2** years while the oldest is **62** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,243** with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,862,548**.

In terms of **County** distribution, Nairobi and Turkana have **3** cases each.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**2**), 10-19 years (**0**), 20-29 years (**0**), 30-39 (**0**), 40-49 (**3**) 50-59 (**0**), 60 years and above (**1**).

Today, **12** patients have recovered from the disease, **all** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,443** of whom **278,834** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,609** are from various

health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,674**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(411)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **17** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **109** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **2** other patients are on supplemental oxygen and are in the general ward.
