PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION:

As of September 6th 2022, a total of **21,236,626** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **17,747,524** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above).

An additional **1,936,588** are doses administered to those between

15 to 17 years, **403,403** are below 15 years but above 12 years while **1,149,111** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **12,228** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **4,520**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **34.7%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033** people.

Today, **16** people have tested positive from a sample size of **1,048**

tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.5%**. **12** of the cases are Kenyans while **4** are Foreigners. **15** are male while **1** is female. The youngest is aged **7** years while the oldest is **64** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,259** with cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,863,596**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **9** of the cases are from Trans Nzoia while Nairobi has **7** cases.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years **(1)**, 10-19 years **(2)**, 20-29 years **(2)**, 30-39 **(3)**, 40-49 **(5)** 50-59 **(1)**, 60 years and above **(2)**.

Today, **48** patients have recovered from the disease, **43** from the Home Based and Isolation Care Program while **5** are from various facilities countrywide. This pushes the total recoveries to **332,491** of whom **278,877** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,614** are from various health facilities across the

country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,674**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years **(62)**, 10-19 years **(44)**, 20-29 **(151)**, 30-39 years **(411)**, 40-49 years **(652)**, 50-59 years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **14** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **80** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.
