## **UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRY AND RESPONSE**

### **PRESS STATEMENT**

Today, **10** people have tested positive from a sample size of **964** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **1.0%**. **8** of the cases are Kenyans while **2** are Foreigners. **6** are male while **4** are female. The youngest is aged **1** years while the oldest is **66** years old. Total confirmed positive cases are now **338,434** with

cumulative tests so far conducted standing at **3,884,414**.

In terms of **County** distribution, **9** cases are from Nairobi while Laikipia has **1** case.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (**2**), 10-19 years (**1**), 20-29 years (**1**), 30-39 (**2**), 40-49 (**2**) 50-59 (**1**), 60 years and above (**1**).

No discharges were recorded in the last 24 hours so the cumulative recoveries remain **332,669** of whom **279,052** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **53,617** are from various health facilities across the country.

No fatalities were recorded during the period under review so the cumulative fatalities remain at **5,678**.

Cumulative deaths by age remain; 0-9 years (**62**), 10-19 years (**44**), 20-29 (**152**), 30-39 years (**413**), 40-49 years (**653**), 50-59

years **(1,032)**, 60 years and above **(3,322)**.

There are **11** patients currently admitted in our health facilities, while **66** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **1** other patient is on supplemental oxygen and is in the general ward.

## **VACCINATION:**

As of September 28<sup>th</sup> 2022, a total of **22,028,431** vaccines have been administered across the country. Of these, **18,024,805** are doses administered to the adult population (18 years and above). An additional **2,637,701** are doses administered to those between 12 to below 18 years while **1,365,925** are booster doses.

The total number of vaccines administered in the last 24 hours is **80,046** while the total number of people fully vaccinated over the last 24 hours stand at **20,187**. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **35.5%**. The Government is working towards vaccinating a

targeted population of **27,246,033** people.
